



NORC AmeriSpeak Omnibus Survey: Most Americans Believe Sexual Assault Is a Widespread Problem in Society

Interview Dates: October 11-14, 2018

Nationally representative sample of 1,098 English-speaking adults age 18 and over, conducted using the AmeriSpeak® Panel, the probability-based panel of NORC at the University of Chicago.

Of the 1,098 respondents, 122 completed the survey by phone and 976 via the web.

Margin of error: +/- 4.05 percentage points at the 95% confidence level among all adults

NOTE: All results show percentages among respondents, unless otherwise labeled.



HELP TEXT: Sexual assault refers to a wide range of crimes, including attacks or attempted attacks generally involving unwanted sexual contact between a victim and offender. Sexual assaults may or may not involve force and include such things as grabbing or fondling. It also includes verbal threats.
