Study Methodology

This survey was funded and conducted by NORC at the University of Chicago.

Data were collected in Russia using a random sample of 1,046 Russians aged 18 and older who own a mobile phone number with one of Russia's mobile service providers. Mobile numbers in Russia have ten digits. The first three digits are the mobile provider code. The last seven digits of the mobile number were generated randomly. The sample frame covered Russian mobile numbers from the whole country, including Crimea, which was annexed by Russia in March 2014, and excluded the Russia-controlled parts of Donbas and Southern Ukraine.

A total of 1,046 interviews were conducted between November 13-21, 2023. The numbers were dialed randomly using the CATI method, without quotas, with up to three callbacks. Interviews were conducted by live interviewers in Russian.

The overall margin of sampling error is +/- 3.4 percentage points at the 95 percent confidence level, including the design effect. The margin of sampling error may be higher for subgroups. Sampling error is only one of many potential sources of error and there may be other unmeasured error in this or any other survey.

Quality assurance checks were conducted to ensure data quality, including continuous supervision of interviewing and logical checks of completed interviews. In total, two cases were dropped after quality control. Once the sample has been selected and fielded, and all the study data have been collected and made final, a poststratification weighting was used to adjust for any survey nonresponse as well as any noncoverage or under and oversampling resulting from the study specific sample design. Poststratification variables included age, gender, education, and size of settlement within the federal district. Weighting coefficients were calculated on the basis of Rosstat data on the socio-demographic and territorial composition of the Russian population as of 01.01.2022.
