



AARP-NORC Foresight 50+ Omnibus Survey: Public Health Emergencies

Interview Dates: September 16–20, 2021

Nationally representative sample of 1,057 English-speaking adults age 50 and over, conducted using the Foresight 50+ Panel, the probability-based panel of NORC at the University of Chicago.

Of the 1,057 respondents, 53 completed the survey by phone and 1,004 via web.

The self-funded poll was conducted during a monthly Omnibus survey. It included 1,057 interviews with a nationally representative sample (margin of error is +/-4.24 percent) of adult Americans age 50+ using the Foresight50+ Omnibus Panel. Funded and operated by NORC, Foresight 50+ is a probability-based panel designed to be representative of the U.S. household population age 50 or older. During the initial recruitment phase of the panel, randomly selected U.S. households were sampled with a known, non-zero probability of selection from the NORC National Sample Frame or a secondary national address frame, both with over 97% coverage of all U.S. addresses, and then contacted by U.S. mail, email, telephone, or field interviewers (face to face). Households were screened for having at least one adult age 50 and older. The panel provides sample coverage of approximately 97% of the U.S. household population. Those excluded from the sample include people with P.O. Box-only addresses, some addresses not listed in the USPS Delivery Sequence File, and some newly constructed dwellings population. The panel also excludes people who live in some institutional types of settings, such as nursing facilities or nursing homes, depending on how addresses are listed for the facility.
